

Dear Parent/Carer,

Our children are an amazingly resilient bunch. They have worked extremely hard this week, building up their learning stamina and remembering what it is to be a Thundersley Learner - to believe in yourself, learn from mistakes, work hard and never give up! These attitudes have been mirrored in our assemblies, which have focussed on self-efficacy or selfbelief. The children have been encouraged to 'have a go' at set targets and keep on trying. They have seen examples, through fictions and the stories of people's lives that you can improve your self-efficacy through setting goals and being determined. If you can continue this theme at home, we would be most grateful. Next week's theme is 'Hope'.

With this newsletter, you will find our plan for 'Step-up September' which shows how we are supporting all children to get back to normal in respect of their learning. It also includes strategies for supporting those who are struggling emotionally or have fallen behind academically. You can see that you form a vital part of this, particularly as working one to one with children is more tricky now. Sadly, we cannot have our normal huge band of volunteers to help with reading, so it is absolutely crucial that children are reading at home, which I know can be hard to fit in, but I am not overstating the case to say that your children's future literally depends on it! If we find that families are not managing to read, a member of the Senior Leadership Team will make contact to find out what we can do to help. Just as was the case during Lockdown, we are all in this together - and I know we can step up to the challenge.

Our new little EYFS children start their school life at Thundersley next week so we are looking forward to welcoming them all.


