

Local Governing Body

Each academy in the ROBUS Multi-Academy Trust has a Local Governing Body. The exact composition of the Local Governing Body is at the discretion of the individual academy as long as the structure has Trust Board approval.

At Thundersley Primary School the Local Governing Body is made of 12 governors, including 3 parent governors. The Local Governing Body also has a clerk who takes the minutes of the meetings and prepares the agenda in consultation with the Chair to the Local Governing Body or relevant committee.
