Every child in school has a Thunderbolts Reading List in their Reading Diaries. This is a list of suggested reading books that we hope your child will enjoy. We would like them to read as many of these books as possible, so that by the time they leave TPS they will have enjoyed a huge range of literature. Your child does not have to read the books independently. If an adult reads one of the books on the list to your child, then your child can still mark the book as read. Children of all ages should still be listening to stories read by adults as this allows them to access books that they might not be able to read by themselves. It really helps them to develop their vocabulary and comprehension skills and children really enjoy listening to stories. Teachers will occasionally choose books from the Thunderbolts lists to read to their class so children can tick these titles off too. We have all of the KS2 Thunderbolts books in school and many of the EYFS and KS1 books, although we are hoping to stock up on these throughout the year. Perhaps, once your child has finished a book on this list they might like to donate it to the school so that other children can enjoy it. (We will, of course, quarantine any donated books before putting them into circulation).


