- Maths

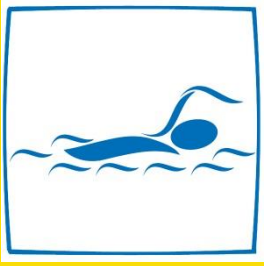


- We keep this low key for the children.

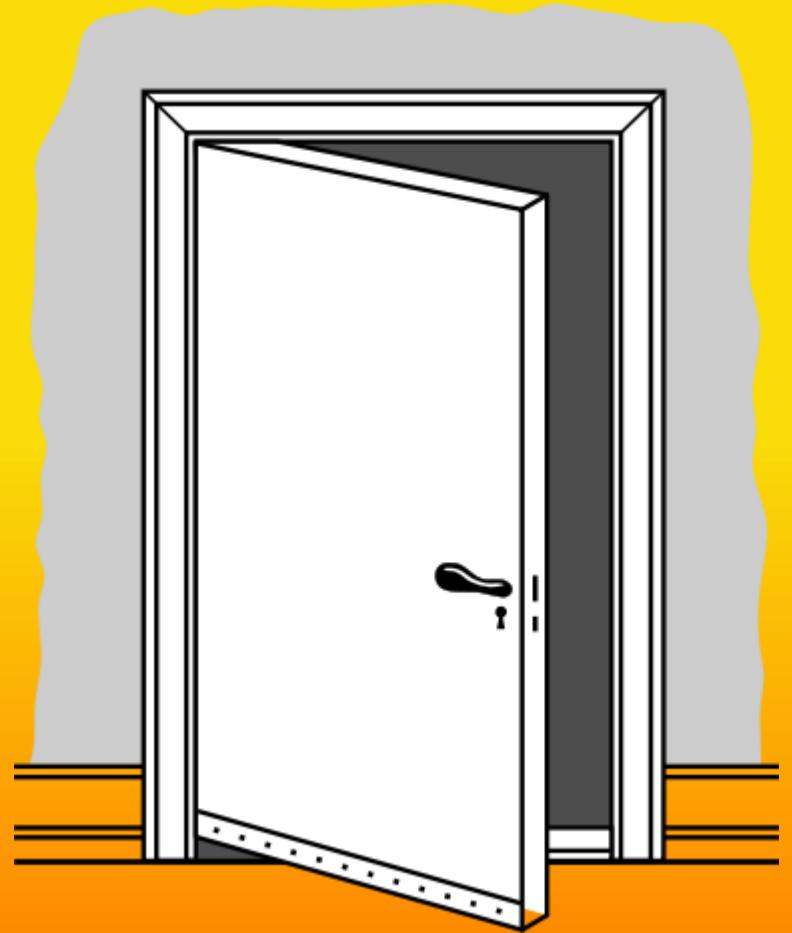
